Queensland 3000m Championships – QSAC

Our club members had excellent results in the 3000m Queensland Championships held at QSAC, Brisbane on Saturday night 9/02/2019.

Age groups of U15, U/16, U/17, U/18yrs and Open were contested at these championships. A record number of over 185 athletes competed at this championship, a marvelous sight when you see at least 15 or more athletes in each race going for gold. Strategies and fitness are so important in achieving a great result, well done to all.

Jude raced well with a perfectly judged pace (his first time at this distance), looking very comfortable, but the way he kicked in the last lap was sensational going on to win the gold medal.

However his club mate and training partner Alex grabbed the bronze medal in a magnificent performance over the last 150m of the race after sitting on the pace throughout, this was an 18 second improvement on last year championships, a very exciting race.

Jude and Alex have now qualified for the Australian Athletics Championships in Sydney from the 1st to 7th April 2019 where the qualifying mark is 9.00.00 making them very competitive.

Jude and Alex run almost every Saturday morning in the 5km Ipswich Parkrun where they are regular place getters. Lots of fun is had at this event.

Both of these athletes have a bright future in middle distance running.

Having won this race two years ago it was still sensational as Tamara stormed home over the last 200m after sitting on the pace for much of the race setting a new **PB**.

Tamara has now qualified for the Australian Athletics Championships in Sydney from the 1st to 7th April 2019 where the qualifying mark is 9.55.00 making her very competitive.

Tamara was Club champion way back in 2007-08 when she competed at World X-Country championships. Her longevity in the sport is absolutely amazing.

Harry Wilson ran superbly when he claimed 2nd position in the Open 3000m "C" division with a time of 9.29.11 after being well down in the placings during the early part and middle parts of the race. He is another young athlete (18yrs old this year) with a bright future in middle distance running. He would have learnt a lot from the experience in his first season of racing.

Kiir Kiir (20yrs) also ran in the Open "C" Division race and was placed 11th in a time of 10.08.13. Kiir is another who has to adapt to pace for this type of event. He has the ability.






