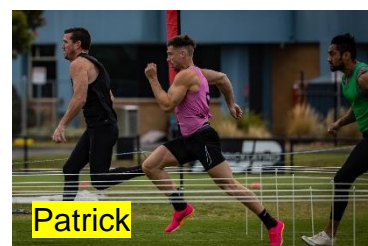

So great handicapping between Stewart and Jude given their respective 3000m PBs of 7:28.02 (current Oceania Record Holder) and 7:47.26 to give the crowd a thrilling finish.

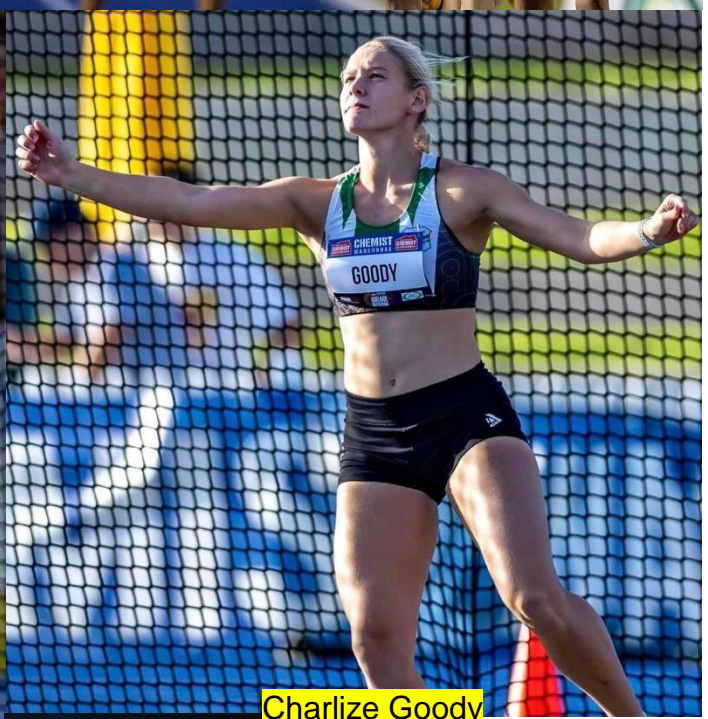
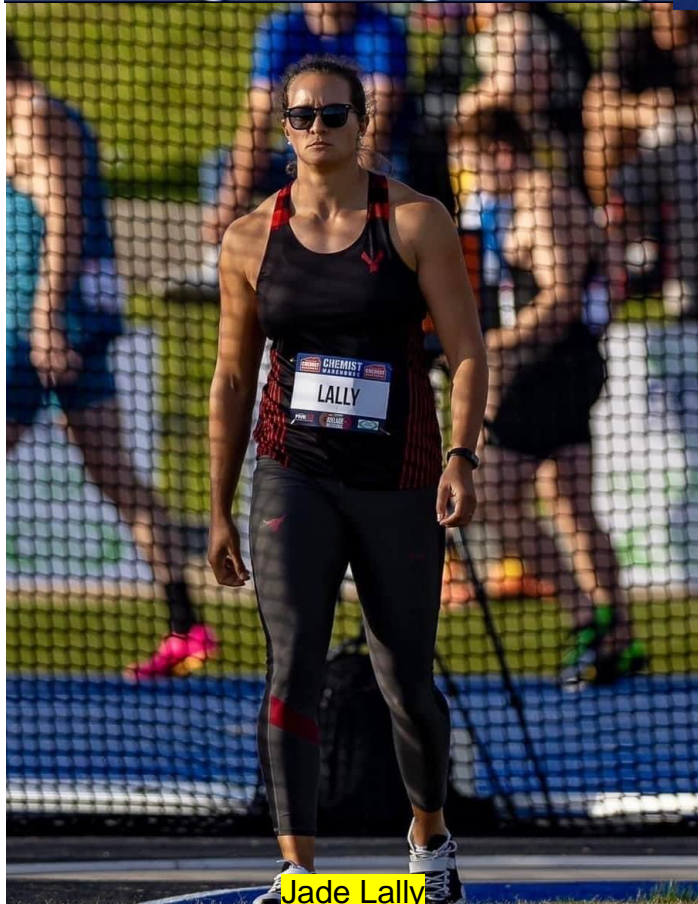

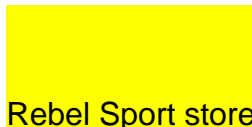
Adelaide Invitational Meet – 11/02/2023

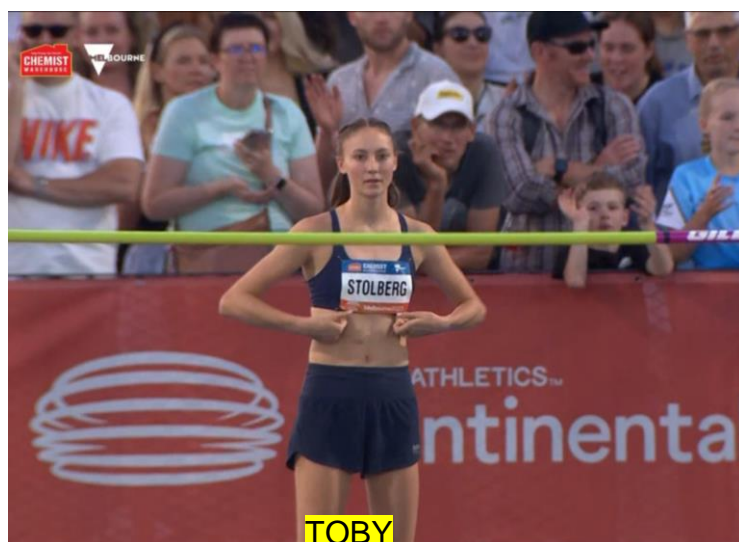
23rd February 2023
