Pak'nSave Cooks One Mile Classic Championship, NZL

It was held at Cooks Gardens in Whanganui, New Zealand on 28/01/2023 in wet and raining conditions.

Jude Thomas our Club Captain was invited to run with other Australian runners which included Callum Davies, a local Brisbane runner as well as Georgia Griffith and Sara Billings from Melbourne. Michael Thomas was an accredited photographer getting some great pictures.

Jude running his first mile race finished 3rd in 3.58.29 to Olympian Sam Turner 3.54.56 a PB and Callum Davies 2nd in 3.56.05 with the national 800m Champion James Preston in 4th position in 3.59.44, a thrilling race. For all four athletes to have dipped under the four minute mile barrier is a landmark for all who raced, as this historic venue has now witnessed 75 sub four minute mile performances.

First broken in 1954 by Roger Bannister, the four minute mile still represents a key milestone for middle distance runners today despite the fact that the world record has moved down to 3.43.13, an incredible feat set in Rome 1999.









Congratulations

Para athlete Hayden White T/F38 has started a remarkable career in para athletics when he competes against able-bodied athletes at interclub Shield Meets by breaking not only one record, he breaks two records.

Hayden is now the current Queensland record holder for the 400m and 800m, well deserved as he puts in the work at training ever since joining the Club this season.
