Oceania Athletic Championships, Townsville 25 - 28/06/2019



It was great to see the support from the families of our athletes.





Club athlete **Jude Thomas** won the Silver medal on the Wednesday in the U/18yrs 1500m in a time of 3.53.97, it was a PB of 0.09 seconds. Then on Friday in the 3000m Jude won the Gold medal setting an Oceania meet record of 8.36.91 which had stood since 2004. This race was a combined age group of U/20 and U/18yrs competitors where Jude ran sensationally over the last 200m to win the race outright, beating the older athletes. A wonderful achievement by Jude as the race callers did not rate the younger athletes to figure in the finish during the call of the event. Jude is coached by Peter Reeves and has a very high opinion for his future endeavours.

Another Club athlete **Kirra Csurhes** won the Silver medal in the U/20yrs 100m Hurdles in a time of 14.71 just edging out the New Zealander by thousandths of a second as both were given 14.71. Kirra had to wait until Friday after arriving with the team on Monday, getting in final training sessions as required. It was a nervous few days but in the end all the training had paid off. Vic Pascoe is her Coach and believes there is further improvement still to come.
